6 PM - MID	Snow showers to light steady snow by 7-9pm	1 - 2 inches	28-31 F	NE at 13-18 Gusting 20-30
Special Notes	Morning snow showers melting on above freezing pavements. Air/pavement temperatures falling and untreated surfaces developing ICY SPOTS between 2-6pm. A steady plowable snow developing this evening and accumulating overnight.

MID - 6 AM	Light snow becoming moderate from 1-5am	2 - 4 inches	26-29 F	N at 18-25 Gusting 30-40
6 AM - NOON	Moderate snow becoming light by 5-6am then ending by 7-9am	Up to 1 inch	26-32 F	NW at 17-23 Gusting 30-35
NOON - 6 PM	Clouds breaking to sunshine		32-34 F	NW at 15-20 Gusting 25-35
6 PM - MID	Mostly clear		25-32 F	NW at 10-15
Special Notes	Moderate snow before dawn. Storm ending 7-9am. Strong wind blowing snow back on pavements through afternoon. Above freezing afternoon temperatures cause some snow melt with a re-freeze on untreated surfaces this evening so watch for icy spots.
